  - A contribution in kind could consist, for example, of one or more of the following things: access to datasets, access to or use of the facilities provided by the collaborative partner, without which the research project would not be possible.
  - Whether a representative from the collaborative partner's organisation will act as a co-supervisor for the student and their research project.
